Officer Schouten report: Comparison January 1st- August 31st (2022-2023)

- Burglary/Theft from Vehicle decreased 24%
- Robbery increased 64%
- Shoplifting increased 31%
- Stolen Vehicles decreased 29%
- Homeless Calls for services increased 48%
