- **MODE** of transportation: make / model bike, skateboard, etc. color # of doors license plate as much as possible direction traveling distinguishing traits dents, stickers, wheels, etc.
- **NUMBER** of people involved?
- **RECOGNIZE** anyone?
- WHEN did it happen?
- WEAPON used?
- PERSON, PROPERTY OR VEHICLE crime?
