WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS.....L. Cordell

Lisa Cordell opened the meeting at 10:00 AM with short welcome and introductions.

ESTABLISH MEETING GUIDELINES.....L. Cordell

Lisa Cordell provided a brief overview of the meeting guidelines to establish rules for maintaining the meeting's focus. Attendees were encouraged to limit discussions related to agenda items and to remain cognizant of the time constraints. The meeting is scheduled to last for one hour, concluding at 11:00 AM.

REPORTS.....L. Cordell

- Citrus Height Police Department (Stats YTD September) - Stats were provided by Commander Frey. Officer Herman discussed Flock Cameras and their effectiveness. CHPD also introduced Ilya Bezuglov, the CHPD detective focused on retail theft crimes.
- Sunrise MarketPlace (Stats Security/Porter Service) - Lisa Cordell presented statistics for attendees to review at their convenience. She explained that upcoming meetings will involve a more in-depth analysis of these numbers in order to identify emerging trends.

SECURITY TOPICS FOR DISCUSSION.....K. Carpenter

- **Hot Spots (Identify hot spots for crime)** - Kathilynn provided a brief overview of the typical hot spots associated with criminal activity in our area. These predominantly involve vacant buildings that tend to attract offenses such as break-ins, vandalism, and illegal dumping. In future meetings, we aim to concentrate on these hot spots to develop strategies for reducing criminal activity and to identify preventative measures. Attendees are encouraged to report any identified hot spots either by emailing Kathilynn or by bringing them to our upcoming meetings.



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- **Holiday/Winter Strategy (Retail Theft and Break-Ins)** - Item moved to next meeting
- **602's (Top 10 list)** - Lieutenant Herman provided a brief overview of the 602 process and its interaction with the nuisance offender program. He also discussed the initiative that the City of Citrus Heights may pursue with the District Attorney's office, aimed at addressing the issue of chronic nuisance offenders with the intent to prosecute habitual offenders.
- **Prop 36** - Lisa Cordell distributed a handout for attendees to review at their convenience concerning the recently passed Proposition 36.
- **Hours of Operation** - Item moved to next meeting.
- **First Amendment Speech & Application of Pruneyard Requirements** - Kathilynn encouraged all attendees with shopping centers to have a First Amendment Speech policy in place.
