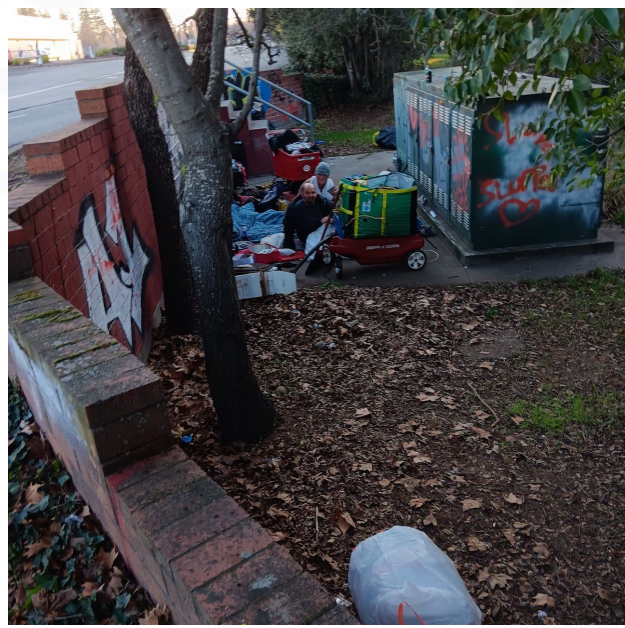


Issues/Activities

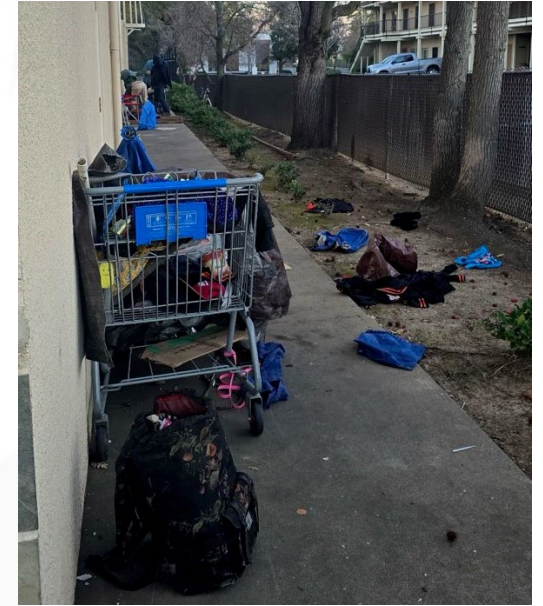

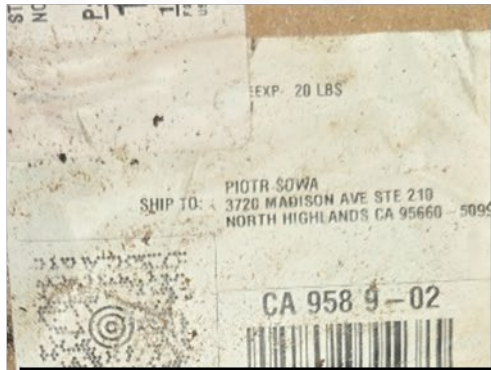

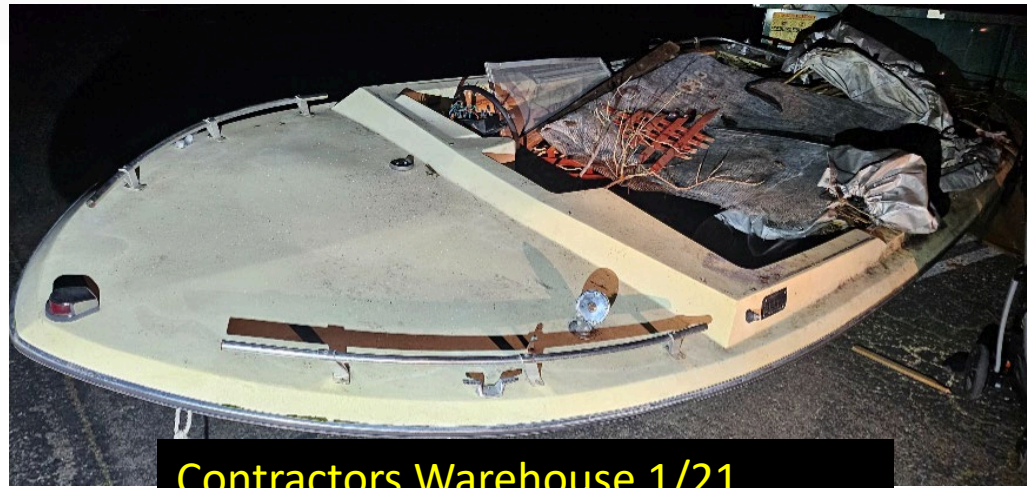
